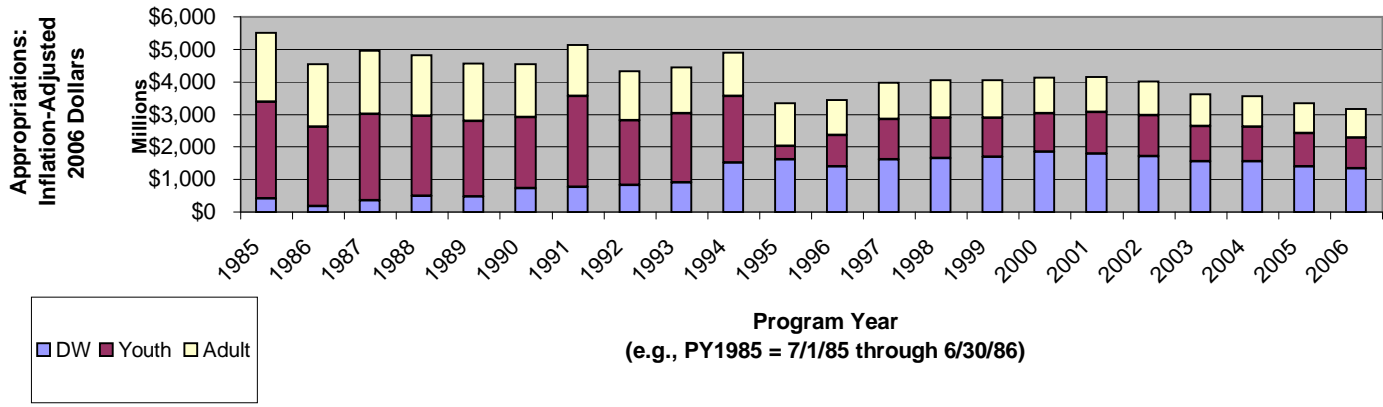

Notes:

#1: Prior to 1993, the JTPA Adult and Youth Training were funded through the JTPA II-A Block Grant. The legislation mandated that no more than 60% of these funds could be used for Adults. At the suggestion of a Department of Labor official, the Workforce Alliance uses a 60%/40% split to derive Adult and Youth funding between 1985-1992, which WWA has also used in this data.

#2: After 1999, Summer Youth and Year-Round Youth Training were consolidated into a single Youth funding source. Figures through 1999 include the summer youth program.



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
